BBQ

Portage Paradise has a BBQ for guest use. Please ensure the gas is turned off after each use. The BBQ needs to be cleaned upon departure, otherwise a cleaning fee of NZ\$50 per hour or part thereof will be charged. If the gas bottle is low or empty, please text us and leave the gas bottle at the front door.
